You Must PROGRESS in your adult cognitive development.

Socialized Mind: the most important things are the ideas, norms and beliefs of the people and systems around us (i.e. family, society, ideology, culture, etc.). 58%

Self-Authoring Mind: we can define who we are, and not be defined by other people, our relationships or the environment. 35%

Self-Transforming Mind: one's sense of self is not tied to particular identities or roles, but is constantly created through the exploration of one's identities and roles and further honed through interactions with others. 1%
