- 3) We rationalize the moisture our world creates and the movement of the stars (don't actually move, but we do)
- 4) We dismiss the natural order in the zoological world.
- 5) We overestimate our own ability to achieve mastery and dominance.
- 6) We question God (or blame him) when we don't understand events (how could God...)

How can we begin to recognize the Majestic Sovereignty of God?

- 1) Begin each day with gratitude to God for the blessings of this world and our life in it.
- 2) Re-envision our lives as a Steward for those things which God provides.
- 3) Daily take actions as a steward of God's many blessings.
